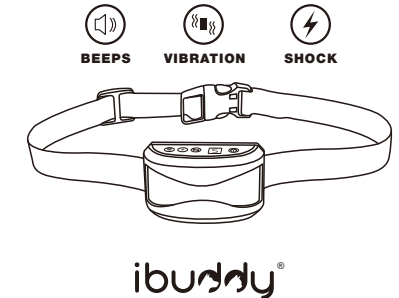


No Bark Collar

User Manual

IMPORTANT Safety Information

WARNING

Not for aggressive dogs. DO NOT USE this product if your dog is aggressive. Or if your dog is prone to do aggressive behavior.

Aggressive dog may become more aggressive with the collar's stimulus. Aggressive behavior should be corrected by certified trainer. If you are unsure whether this collar is appropriate for your dog or not, please consult your veterinarian or certified trainer. The No Bark Collar MUST be used for healthy dogs. This collar is not appropriate for use on puppy weight less than 6 pounds or dog under 6 months old. We recommend you to take your dog to a veterinarian for health checking before using the collar if he or she is not in good health.

Please use the lowest level of vibration and static shock for at the beginning to train your dog. Make sure the level is at the lowest setting for the first use.

CAUTION:

Risk of skin damage. Please read the following instructions carefully. Proper fit of the collar is important, because a loose collar may cause invalid performance. Too long or too tight the collar may cause skin damage, ranging from redness because pressure ulcers (commonly know as bedsores).

- Avoid putting the collar on the dog for more than 12 hours per day.
- Try to reposition the collar on the dog's neck every 1 to 2 hours.
- Check the fit to prevent excessive pressure. Follow the instructions on the manual.
- Never tie a dog rope to the collar, it will cause excessive pressure on the contact area.
- Wash the dog's neck area and the contacts of the collar weekly with a damp cloth.
- Check the contact area daily for signs of rash or a sore.
- If a rash or sore is found, stop using the collar until the skin has healed.
- If the condition last beyond 48 hours, please take your dogs to veterinarian.

IMPROPER USING OF THE STATIC SHOCK MODE WILL CAUSE PAIN, PHYSICAL INJURY OR TRAUMATIZATION TO YOUR DOG. THE STATIC SHOCK FEATURE SHOULD ONLY BE USED IN EXTREME SITUATIONS AND ONLY AFTER CONSULATION WITH A PROFESSIONAL DOG TRAINER.

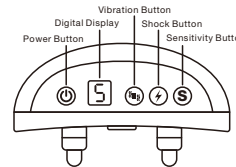

Receiver Collar Definitions

Power on/off

Press "Power Button" once to turn on the receiver collar with beep (1 sound). At the same time, the remaining power is displayed. And press for 3 seconds to turn off the collar with beep (2 sound).



Vibration Button

Ranking from 0-7 you can choose to adjust the vibration, when the vibration is 0, the collar does not vibrate.

Shock Button

Ranking from 0-7 you can choose to adjust the shock, when you set to "0", the shock is turned off. "7" is the maximum.

Sensitive Button

Ranking from 1-7 you can choose to adjust the sensitivity, "1" being the minimum, "7" being the maximum.

Product Working Principle

This collar has a vibration sensor for sensitivity distinction, when the sound of the dog barking reaches a certain frequency, it will trigger the sensors thus firstly trigger product's sound and then the vibration after the shock.

Charge the Collar

Press "Power Button" the remaining power is displayed. When the product is fully charged, the screen will display "7". The charge time takes around 1 hour, and the digital number on the screen will be slowly flashing when charging. Full power can be used for 14 days.

Charging the product with an adapter exceeding 1A is not allowed.

Testing the collar

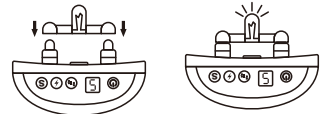
1. Turn on the power
2. Adjust the sensitivity level to 7
3. Blow the collar, it will firstly trigger sound and vibrate then shock.



Static Shock Test

1. Turn on the power
2. Adjust the Shock level over 1
3. Put the Test Bulb on the metal pile.
4. Blow the collar, the test bulb will light up.
(The higher the Static Shock Level is, the brighter the light will be.)

Important! The higher level is, the higher Static Shock will be. Recommend to train your dog at no shock or lower level at the beginning.



Safety Shut Off Setting

If someone's breaking into your house or in some other emergency circumstances which dogs may bark, the collar keeps activating for 7 times in one minute, then it will shut off. The screen's digital number will flash a minute then it will come into operation. In safety shut off setting mode, press any button will wake it up.

Q&A (IMPORTANT)

- Q: Which part of the dog's body can put the receiver?
A: Below the throat.
- Q: I just received the collar yesterday, but it doesn't work, what should I do?
A: Firstly, please confirm whether it electrifies or not and adjust the sensitivity to 7 and blow the collar, to test if there is a response.
- Q: Why it does not work when the dog barking?
A: It won't work if it's loosely fitted or sideways, with proper adjustment it works properly, or upgrade the sensitivity.
- Q: The collar beeps when the dog shocks or moves. Is it normal or the sensitivity is too high?
A: It is normal, and if the sensitivity is too high, turn it down.
- Q: I have a teacup Chihuahua. Will the bark collars too big for them?
A: It really depends on the neck size, but my Pom is 6 pounds and it fits her. She has more hair than anything! There is a lot of room on the collar for sizing.

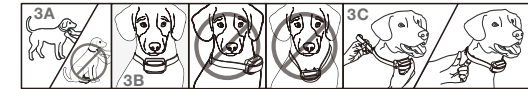
Fit the Collar

The proper fit and placement of the collar is important for effective training.

The contact points must have direct contact with your pet's skin on the underside of the neck.

To assure a proper fit. Please follow these steps:

- Make sure that collar is turned off.
- Have your pet stood comfortably (3A).
- Place the collar on your pet's neck close to the ears. Center the contact points underneath your pet's neck to touch the skin (3B).
- The collar should fit snugly. Loose enough to allow one finger to fit between the strap and your pet's neck (3C).



Tips:

Sometimes you need to trim the hair around the contact point to make sure that contact is consistent.

DO NOT Shave the pet's neck as this may increase the risk of skin irritation.

Tips

- You should choose these functions according to the size of your dogs.
- Refer to the Dog Size Reference Chart for a detailed guideline.
- Sensitivity grade is best suited for your dog.
- Tips for how to choose optimal sensitivity for your dogs:

The size of dog	Mini	Small	Medium	Large	Huge
Sensitivity grade	7	7	6-7	4-5	3

- You can adjust the sensitivity from the highest sensitivity 7. If your dog is accustomed to the sensitivity levels, you can lower the sensitivity grade.
- You are recommended to use sound function first (The sound is default setting), then choosing the vibration function or static shock function according to how your dog responds to the collar.
- You are recommended to use the static shock function from the weakest grade 1.
- Tips for how to choose optimal vibration function or static shock function for your dogs: (The sound is default setting).
